General information for campers at Seeland Camp in Meisberg

Welcome to our little paradise!
 You've decided to spend some relaxing time at the Seeland Camp - enjoy! To ensure a peaceful stay,
 please observe the following rules:

1a	Music and conversation	Do you enjoy listening to music, talking with family and friends? Enjoy! Please do so at a reasonable volume at all times.
1b	Rest hours	Night rest: 22:00 - 07:00h / Lunch rest: 12:00-14:00h - Thank you ☺!
2a	Parking your car overnight	2a Parking your car overnight Are you a night owl and want to leave the campsite and/or return between 22:00 and 07:00? Then please park your car in the western part of the car park. Access to the campsite is closed after 10pm.
2b	Speed on the road	The speed limit on the access road to the campsite is 40 km/h. Please only drive at 30 km/h up and down the road to/from the village in consideration of the residents. This applies both day and night.
3	Visitors	Visitors Guests or day campers are also welcome. Please inform your guests that <u>after 10pm, the night rest period applies, and that they must leave the area.</u> Otherwise, they will be treated as overnight guests. See our current rates for day guests.
4a	Games	On the west side of our building is a large play area and our sunbathing lawn. Make the most of it! Please respect the areas for ball games and other outdoor games. The pitch is open from 08.30 - 22.00h
4b	Barbecue/picnic areas with tables	Barbecue areas are available free of charge during opening hours. They can also be booked for groups. To make a reservation, please go to reception or send us an email at info@seeland-camp.ch . Please include your contact details and all necessary information.
5	Dogs	Dogs are also welcome at Seeland Camp! However, we do ask that dogs are kept on a lead throughout the campsite area. Please also ensure that you have a "Robidog bag" with you at all times (a plastic bag for picking up droppings). The Robidog post is located at the west entrance to the campsite.
6	Swimming pool	Fancy a swim? Admission to the swimming pool is included in the price of accommodation. The pool is open from mid-May to mid-September. Visitors to campers pay a daily entry fee according to the current rates. Swimming pool opening times: As posted at the entrance. Please note the pool rules! > Pool rules sheet > Information boards in the pool area IMPORTANT: Use of the pool is at your own risk! Children up to the age of 16 may only use the pool if accompanied by an adult
7a	Excursions	Our region offers a wide range of exciting excursions - in good weather and bad. Don't hesitate to ask us for more information!

7b	Departure	<p>Please pay for your stay the day before your departure.</p> <p>You can pay by cash (CHF and EUR, TWINT or credit card. Office opening hours: As per information board at the entrance.</p> <p>Please vacate your place before 12.00 p.m. so that it is available for new guests from midday. Depending on availability, the stay may be extended (for a fee as per our price list).</p>
8a	Use of water	<p>There are water taps in the basement of the main building (towards the forest). There are two other taps on the campsite. The water is of drinking quality.</p>
8c	Washing machine and tumble dryer	<p>A washing machine and tumble dryer are available in the laundry room in the basement of the building. Please register on the reservations list in the laundry room and settle your account at reception. Stewis are available in the changing rooms. Please do not hang ropes between the trees.</p>
8d	Shower	<p>Shower is included in the price of accommodation.</p>
9	W-LAN	<p>You have free access to the WLAN seeland camp-guest in the vicinity of the main building. Please ask at reception for the WIFI code.</p>
10	Rubbish	<p>From a stay of 2 nights, you are obliged to buy a rubbish bag with a stamp from us (17l bag and stamp CHF 2.- / 35l bag CHF 2.70). If you use your own bag, you can buy a stamp at reception. Stick the stamp on the waste bag and place it in the container provided in the western part of the car park. There are also containers for green waste and empty bottles/glasses. PET and aluminium containers are available in the company building.</p>
11a	Café / kiosk	<p>Our kiosk sells drinks, snacks, coffee, cakes and various other food products.. In the neighbouring villages of Safnern, Lengnau, Pieterlen, Büren or in Biel / Bienne you will find additional shops.</p>
11b	Restaurant hall	<p>This is currently used as a function room and - in bad weather - as a café and lounge. It is also open in the evenings on request.</p>
